## AMERICAN, BRITISH AND SOUTH AFRICAN ICONS Research project Teachers' Notes

This activity have been designed for intermediate, upper-intermediate and advanced students to be used before the event as an introduction and a way of getting students interested in the subject.

## Procedure:

- 1. Split students into groups of 3, then assign one politician to each student in a group.
- 2. Ask students to do some research on their politician at home.
- 3. In the following class, organise the groups so that in a group of 3 everyone has done research on a different politician.
- 4. Ask students to provide answers to all the questions: they first answer question 1 sharing information on all the politicians, then move to question 2 etc.
